

Numbering System for Standing Rules

- The purpose of standing rules is to officially document rules by which Snowlands Network is managed. They are used to expand and clarify the Bylaws, and to set rules on topics not included in the Bylaws.
- Standing rules are created by a vote of the Board of Directors.
- Standing rules have a numbering system, e.g. SR XX.YY.ZZ, where
 - “XX” refers to the article number of the Bylaws to which the standing rule applies.
 - “YY” refers to the section number of the article of the Bylaws to which the standing rule applies.
 - “ZZ” is sequentially incremented beginning with “1” for each standing rule associated with “XX.YY”.
 - For subjects not covered in the Bylaws:
 - “XX” is set to “12”.
 - “YY” is incremented beginning with “1” for each new subject.
 - “ZZ” is incremented beginning with “1” for each standing rule associated with “12.YY”.
